
TRIP SUMMARY & ITINERARY

DAYS 1 - 3

Arrive in one of the world's global financial hubs and China's largest city, Shanghai. Spend the day exploring the city and enjoy an incredible acrobatic show combining Chinese history with martial arts and special effects.

TAKE IN THE RENOWNED SHANGHAI SKYLINE ATOP THE WORLD'S 2ND TALLEST BUILDING.

Take a break from the busy city to visit Tongli Village, an ancient Wu region town known as 'the Venice of the Orient'. Here you'll explore the 49 bridges and narrow canals on a gondola-style boat.





DAYS 4 - 6

Take a cruise from Guilin to the ancient town of Yangshuo along the beautiful Li River and discover the incredible limestone rock formations and luscious landscape. Lunch will be onboard with fresh catches from the Li River. Visit the colourful bustling markets and street vendors in the beautiful town of Yangshuo.

DISCOVER THE NATURAL AND HISTORICAL SECRETS OF CHINA

Take an early flight from Guilin to Xi'an one of China's oldest cities and one of the four great ancient capital's. Xi'an is the starting point of the Silk Road, and it is here where the Army of Terracotta Warriors lives. Cycle China's most complete surviving city wall and one of the largest ancient military defensive systems in the world. This evening enjoy exploring the Muslim Market and sample some local delicacies.



DAYS 7 - 10

Visit the incredible army of over 7000 soldiers, horses, archers and chariots in full battle array which have guarded Emperor Qin's tomb since 210BC.

VISIT ONE OF THE SEVEN WONDERS OF THE WORLD: THE GREAT WALL OF CHINA.

Take Hutong tour on a rickshaw through local dwellings from the Yuan period which are fast disappearing. visit the Forbidden City, which was the imperial palace to 24 emperors during the Ming and Qing Dynasties from 1402 to 1911.
